



Applications approved at the November 2019 Shropshire RCC Grants Committee meeting

Millichope Fund for Community Buildings

- Eaton Constantine Village Hall - £500 was awarded towards the cost of removal and replacement of asbestos guttering.
- Ellerdine Village Hall - £423 was awarded towards the cost of an instant water heater, an extractor fan and food prep island.
- Stanton upon Hine Heath (originally Twemlows – moved to Millichope) - £500 for sanding and polishing of the floor.

Shropshire Grassroots Fund

- Shropshire Army Cadet Force (Wem Branch) - £179.99 towards purchase 3 of tents for DoE expeditions.
- Brownlow Community Centre - £100 towards the cost of leaflet printing.
- Cleobury Mortimer Men's Shed - £500 promissory (once shed is complete) awarded for protective clothing.

Twemlows Community Energy Fund

- Welshampton Parish Hall - £1000 towards replacing windows and doors.
- West Felton Village Hall - £1,000 towards heaters for the Hall.
- Shropshire Sailing Club – agreed in principle for when work started, deferred to next year if funds available.

Grindley Brook

In summer 2019 we set up a small grant scheme for village halls within 10 miles of Grindley Brook, which stretched into Wales (Wrexham) and Cheshire. The fund was set up by Shropshire RCC after it became the Custodian Trustees of a moribund charity "The Grindley Brook Recreation Rooms". The Charity had ceased to operate because the Recreation Rooms had been demolished and the land sold for housing.

Halls in Shropshire could apply for up to £1,000 (including match funding from the Twemlows Community Energy Fund) and halls in Cheshire or Wales could apply for up to £500.

- Tilston Village Hall (Cheshire) - £493
- Malpas Village Hall (Cheshire) – £500
- Edstaston Village Hall - £443
- Brownlow Village Hall - £1,000
- Lyon Village Hall - £500
